## 11th Annual International Academy of Cardiovascular Sciences-North American Section (IACS-NAS)

The Texas Heart Institute is honored to host the 11th Annual International Academy of Cardiovascular Sciences-North American Section (IACS-NAS) Symposium from September 19-21, 2024. The three-day conference will bring world-class cardiovascular experts together with physicians, basic scientists, clinical investigators, clinical practitioners, and trainees (both clinical and basic science) from across the country to share the latest cardiovascular discoveries.

This year, the symposium will also host a special tribute to James T. Willerson, MD. "The James T. Willerson, M.D. Symposium" will be held on the first day of the conference and will include scientific presentations made by three of Dr. Willerson's colleagues followed by a slide presentation and reception celebrating Dr. Willerson's visionary leadership and his scientific contributions to medicine.

Dr. Willerson served as President of the IACS-NAS from 2011-2014, President of UTHealth Houston from 2001-2008, and President Emeritus of The Texas Heart Institute until his death in 2020. In appreciation of Dr. Willerson's leadership and scientific contributions, the IACS also established the "James Willerson Award for Excellence in Cardiovascular Medicine", which is annually given to a prominent cardiovascular scientist.

The symposium will conclude on Saturday, September 21st, with a formal Dinner & Awards Ceremony at the Westin Houston Medical Center Hotel. The event will begin at 6:30pm (CDT) and is open to all registered attendees, faculty, and special guests!

The IACS-NAS symposium is supported, in part, by participants' registration fees, exhibitors, and educational grants from selected pharmaceutical and device companies.
